OSI Weihai Honored with 3-Star Good Chicken Production Award in China

Award confirms excellent animal welfare performance

Aurora, IL, USA, July 10, 2017 – OSI Group (Weihai) Poultry Development Company was honored with a 2017 3 Star Good Chicken Production Award (GCPA) by the International Cooperation Committee of Animal Welfare (ICCAW), which is under the Minister of Agriculture (MOA) China and cooperates with Compassion In World Farming (CIWF). The award presentation took place on June 28, 2017, in London.

This award recognizes OSI Weihai's significant achievements in <u>animal welfare</u>, including the following best practices that have been implemented, resulting in this 3-Star recognition:

- Birds are kept in conditions with suitable temperature, humidity, ventilation and lighting, and each house has an environment indicator for ammonia, carbon dioxide, etc., to ensure the air is safe
- Stocking density and litter condition are regularly monitored
- Interaction with the birds takes place twice a day to monitor bird health and equipment conditions
- Cleaning, sanitation and disinfection are conducted by batch using All In All Out farm management, which complies with the strictest practices for bio-security and environmental management
- Birds are caught with both hands, and sufficient space is provided to ensure total bird comfort
- Strict record keeping ensures total transparency and traceability

"It is our great honor to receive the 3 Star Good Chicken Production Award from the International Cooperation Committee of Animal Welfare (ICCAW) and Compassion in World Farming (CIWF)," said OSI President and COO, <u>David McDonald</u> in a message displayed at the award ceremony. "We extend our heartfelt gratitude to the ICCAW and the CAPIAC for their support and trust. We will continue to improve and promote animal welfare systems in all our operations."
