Decade long alliance with consulting company minimizes company's carbon footprint

Camberley, Surrey, England, 2017 – Creative Foods Europe has offset over 4,259 tons of carbon dioxide by supporting energy efficient projects in Africa, India and Brazil.

<u>African Energy Efficient Stove Project</u> – Building energy-saving cooking stoves for families along the coastal region of Mombasa in Kenya

- Stoves were built locally to create employment (694 stoves built)
- Reduces the time spent collecting firewood
- Reduces the impact on deforestation (1,812 tons of wood saved so far)
- Brings environmental, social, and financial benefits to the community (Improved 1,215 total respiratory cases with 3,750 people positively impacted)

<u>Clean Water for Life in Uganda</u> – *Finding damaged water supplies and boreholes (wells) and addressing the resulting issues*

- Repairs damage to restore clean water supplies to the community.
- Once water no longer needs to be boiled, carbon credits are generated.
- Carbon finance is used to ensure the long-term continuation of the boreholes and the safeguarding of the community into the future.
- More than 651,000 liters of clean water have been supplied to nearly 300 people, one-third of which are children.

<u>Indian Wind Power Project</u> – *Strategically placing wind turbines to create clean green energy*

- Turbines installed in the Gadag region of India supply power to the southern regional grid, which is dominated by fossil fuel based power plants.
- Carbon credits are generated by this alternate energy source.
- Local communities benefit from increased job creation, improved road connectivity, and new business opportunities.

<u>Brazilian Forestry Project</u> – Organizing the avoidance of deforestation and sustainable forestry management in the Amazon Rainforest

- Protecting the rainforest avoids the release of carbon emissions, since trees act as a natural "sponge" by absorbing carbon dioxide.
- As well as carbon savings, the project supports the Amazon's biodiversity of plants and wildlife.
- The project has developed technical forestry schools, educating local young people as well as working with the state park to develop initiatives and create local forest fire brigades.
